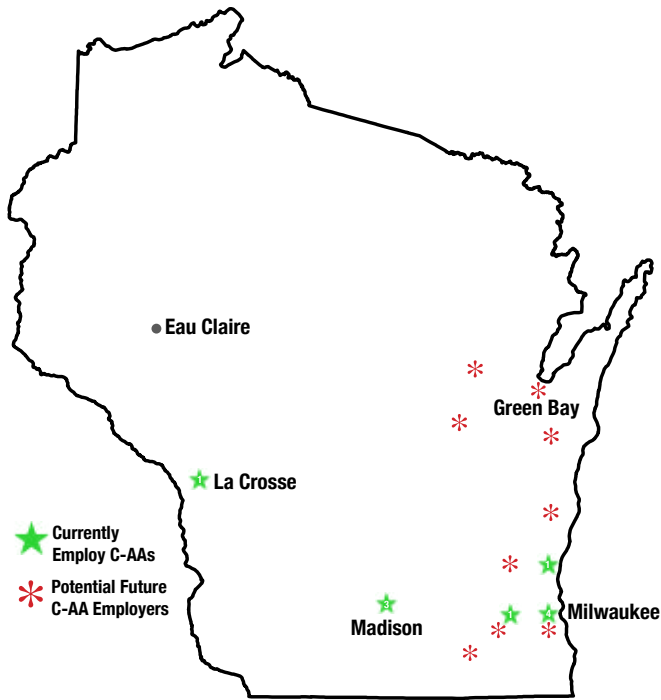


Wisconsin Map of Employment Locations

WAAA Practice Statement

The WAAA subscribes in practice, philosophy and training to the ACT. Within the ACT, an anesthesiologist and C-AA work together to provide anesthesia care in the belief that the interests of patient safety are best served with an anesthesiologist's involvement in the delivery of every anesthetic. The responsibility for medical direction lies with the anesthesiologist, who may then delegate aspects related to the implementation of an anesthetic plan to the C-AA.

Past, Present & Future

- The WAAA was organized in 2006 in an effort to support practicing C-AAs.
- The WAAA was the first state component society recognized by the AAAA.
- Before 2012, C-AAs practiced under delegatory authority by a supervising anesthesiologist. There were 15 C-AAs working in the state at that time.
- C-AA licensure in Wisconsin was achieved in January 2012.
- Currently there are 72 C-AAs working throughout the state in Madison, La Crosse and Milwaukee.
- The Medical College of Wisconsin (MCW) created a C-AA program, becoming the 11th educational program in the nation.
- Future efforts by WAAA leadership will be directed towards workforce expansion within the state (see Wisconsin Employment fold) and maintaining a strong coalition with the Wisconsin Society of Anesthesiologists (WSA) and the AAAA.
